FREQUENTLY ASKED BLITZ QUESTIONS



What is the Giving Blitz?

The Giving Blitz is a new 48-hour fundraising blitz event to support Columbia Ability Alliance. We aim to mobilize our community to raise \$50,000 to help fund our diverse mission programs. The event begins at 12:01 am on Wednesday, August 7, and ends at 11:59 pm on Thursday, August 8.

What do donations go towards?

Gifts made during the Giving Blitz support Columbia Ability Alliance's mission of empowering individuals with unique abilities and life barriers as they achieve independence and personal success. Donors can direct where their donations go – you can choose to support any of our listed programs or projects specifically, or put it towards the area of greatest need.

What are challenges and how do they work?

By partnering with generous community sponsors, we have the potential to garner extra support for our nonprofit programs. We have a slate of nine partners lined up, ready to give big, but only if our community helps us "unlock" these gifts by meeting their specific donation goals.

Is there a minimum gift?

Short answer, no! Ever heard of the ripple effect? The ripple effect underscores the idea that every donation, no matter the size, has the potential to create a ripple of positive change that extends beyond the initial act of giving. Every gift matters, so encourage your networks to give at a level that resonates with them.

Is a Giving Blitz contribution tax-deductible?

The deductibility of any contribution for tax purposes is limited to the amount that exceeds the value of any goods and services donors are entitled to receive in return. Donors will not be receiving any goods or services in exchange for their donations. Please consult with a financial advisor if you have any questions. Donors will automatically receive an emailed receipt.

Do donors have to donate online, or can they contribute in another way?

By addressing these unique barriers, they aim to provide a pathway to stability, self-sufficiency, and a brighter future for all served.

Social Accounts

Follow Columbia Ability Alliance on Facebook, Instagram and LinkedIn (@columbiaabilityalliance)

Hashtag and best practices

The main hashtag is #CAAGivingBlitz.

- Please use #CAAGivingBlitz in all social media posts related to the Giving Blitz.
- Hashtags allow people to search for related content and connect with others. They also allow the team to pull related posts for reporting.
- Don't put spaces within the hashtags. Capitalize the hashtags as shown above for readability.
- When posting to Instagram, change the link in your profile to direct users to the Giving Blitz project you would like to promote and add **Link in bio** to the posts.

Posting Schedule

A detailed calendar of CAA's scheduled social media posts leading up to and during the Blitz can be found on the preceding page. Below are other ideas and ways you can promote the Blitz on your personal or business social accounts.

July 15-31

- Announce that our Giving Blitz is happening August 7-8. You can use the sample pre-event, one-week reminder social media posts provided in this toolkit, create your own social media post using the sample posts as a guide, or share CAA's posts from our social accounts.
- Email your networks using the sample email messages we've provided as a guide. Ask them to join you in making a gift to our upcoming Columbia Ability Alliance Giving Blitz.
- Re-share Giving Blitz content from CAA's social pages.
- Download the social media Giving Blitz graphics at columbiaabilityalliance.com/givingblitz/toolkit, and change your Facebook, Instagram, and LinkedIn profile pictures and your cover photos.
- Using the pre-event post samples as a guide, make a post or two letting your followers know about our Giving Blitz on August 7-8.

August 1-6

- Share your personal or organization's reason behind your sponsorship and involvement with the Giving Blitz. Why does the Columbia Ability Alliance mission matter to **you?**
- Make another post reminding your network to get ready to Blitz!
- Invite your network to attend the Giving Blitz's on-site celebrations on August 7 and 8.

August 7-8: Giving Blitz!

- Post on social media throughout the day, using the #CAAGivingBlitz hashtag and our sample day-of-event social media posts as a guide. What is Ambassador Crowdfunding?

- Navigate to our event page: https://onecau.se/_5rmhp1 or scan the QR code with your phone.
- Click "Become a Fundraiser"
- Input phone number or email address, then follow steps to verify
- Personalize your page: Add a photo and a message about why you are raising funds for Columbia Ability Alliance
- Add a personal fundraising goal
- Click "Create My Page" and start sharing your link!

You'll receive a confirmation text or email, depending on which method you used to sign up, that includes your personal page's link. Use this link to share across your networks to raise funds. You can come back to your personal page any time to edit your information or view your stats!
